The 2012 tournament book will be coming out very soon. I will be e-mailing it to the membership this year, so keep a look out for it in the coming weeks. Make sure and read through it carefully as there have been some changes. The next tournament will be the Chili Bowl on February 25. I hope to see you all there.

As a reminder to all of you, please make sure that you are filling your divots and repairing your ball marks on the green. If you hit your ball into the environmental areas on 5, 13, or 16 you may not play it or look for your ball in this area. It is a protected area and we can't have people walking around or hitting out of these areas. Drop areas are located on those holes for your convenience.

How did I do with merchandise this year? If you have any comments or suggestions that can help improve the golf shop, let me know. I am a big Under Armour fan as you probably noticed from the merchandise ordered throughout the year. However I am open to anything, so please feel free to stop in and voice your opinions to me. Spring apparel should start coming in mid to late February, for those of you looking for some new looks.

Many of you have noticed that we have several "demo" items in the Pro Shop ranging from drivers and fairway woods to iron sets and wedges. Around the Course with Fred Leonard, Director of Golf & Grounds

Believe it or not, the official tournament season for Taberna CC begins at the end of this month with the "Chili Bowl". Although I'm writing this before the actual playing of the "superintendent's revenge" event, I hope everyone found it as amusing as I did when trying to create the most unfair, ridiculously difficult course we could create. Barring playing every hole from the back of the blue tees, that is as hard as I can make it! Jim Lipe was much more accommodating as a golf course architect when designing the greens which means I don't have the "buried elephants" in the greens. At my last course, the pro would bet anyone they couldn't shoot double their normal handicap on the revenge course. I'd say here it would be closer to 1.5x your handicap is a good score for the revenge event!

January weather was much less desirable than that of December for golf and maintenance. I vote for February to mimic December '11! We will continue tree removal and begin spraying another application of a turf herbicide for continued winter weed control. Although we have a weed or two here or there, I have to say that our course is extremely clean of weeds, especially compared to those around us. If you are playing a course that has not intentionally over seeded, for instance, tees: then all the green grass you are playing on is actually annual blue grass or "po anna" as it is commonly referred to: WEEDS! It sometimes goes undetected how much effort goes into weed control so I encourage you to play a local course or two, then come back and compare. We love when that happens!

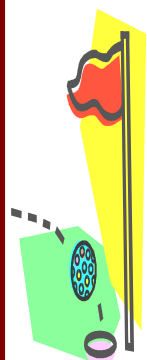
Last year the USGA initiated a program called "Tee It Forward". The purpose is to encourage players to move to a set of tees that matches their skill level. Arnold Palmer is the Honorary Spokesman for the program and if Arnie moves up a set of tees to keep having fun, I think the rest of us can learn from his example. For instance, when I play my 13 year old son, he plays from where his approach shot into the greens are with similar clubs that I use for the approach shot. It would not be fair for me to hit 7 iron into number 3 yet my son must hit a rescue club. The point is he has the chance to score, hit similar irons and shots to those of the pros on TV. with a lesser degree of difficulty. Building confidence and a strong mental game are all positives that come from the program. Give it a try, especially this time of year, and see if you have more fun. Although I generally play the blue tees, it's always fun to play something different, like a red tee day. What is there to lose? If you are just beginning, start each hole from the 150 marker. The point is to have fun!

Every year, I have the suggestion of instituting the "Adopt A Hole" program (#1686). The idea is to assign members golf holes alphabetically. For example: Last names begging with A and B would "adopt" #1. Each time they played that hole or in the evenings when they want to get out after dinner for a some fresh air, they would pick up tees and cigarette butts, fill divots, pick up trash, limbs, debris, etc and help us keep the course pristine. The efforts in the past to try this program have failed. I think the primary reason is many people would prefer to "work" on the hole their home looks ever. I don't intend to make this an official program this year but we will put the "adoption papers" sign up in the locker rooms. If you wish to participate in any way mentioned above, sign up. The point of doing it in a "program" format is to recognize those that take that "extra" pride in their club to donate their time and energy. At my previous club, it also created some competition among the members to have the "cleanest" hole or the green with "no ball marks". We will try it informally this year so if interested, look for the sign up sheet. If you are already doing things like Mr. Gemmill does on the corner of #15, sign up anyway. Your efforts are worthy of recognition so to start this off right: Thank You to Bruce Gemmill and all those that live on #15, their properties aren't separated by any defining features like drainage ditches and those folks have spent allot of their own time and money elevating the beauty of the 15th. Thank you, thank you, thank you.

As mentioned earlier, I hope February weather is good for golf, not ducks! I've become a fan of quotes although I don't seem to retain them for any length of time! They do inspire and motivate me though so as I did last month, I will end this newsletter with a quote not nearly as long as the last: "If the Human Race wishes to have a prolonged and indefinite period of material prosperity, they have only got to behave in a peaceful and helpful way toward one another." Greetings, Ladies-

First, I would like to say how glad I am to be opening a new TWGA season as President. We have an outstanding Board this year, and hope to see everyone at the Kickoff Meeting on February 16th at 5:00 p.m. This year we decided to have the kickoff be purely the General Meeting and social. No golf, no pressure. Just a quick meeting, adult beverages (or soft) and some tasty treats. There will be a sign up sheet in the locker room for those that intend to visit after the meeting.

Before this meeting, the divisions will get together to discuss the upcoming season events, and their closing day. YOUR SERVE

Is it time for a new racquet? Maybe not. If you're looking for new technology to make you a better ball striker, it is out there. Newer racquets are lighter, stiffer, and more comfortable. They produce more power and better control. The major racquet companies change their racquet lines every three to four years. There are still a few break throughs in technology every so often, but most changes are just cosmetic. If you have a racquet less than six years old, you are probably fine.

There are things you can do to upgrade and make your racquet better for you and suit the type of game you want to play.

First you can change the swing weight and balance by adding lead tape. To make the racquet head light add tape under the grip. This will make the head faster through the ball producing more spin and control. For more power (sacrificing a little control) add the lead tape to the very top of the racquet. This makes the racquet head heavy. A head light or head heavy racquet is measured from the middle of the racquet. A unit of measure is a 'point'. A 'point' is 1/8th of an inch. So a 27" racquet that is 8 pts. Head light has a balance point 1 inch from the middle of the racquet toward the handle.

Another tweak you can make to your racquet is to change your grip. After time a grip wears down and gets less absorbent. You can also change your grip size with both grips and over grips. Things to look for when changing your grip or over grip is: thickness, weight, and absorption ability.

A way to get a different feel or sound from your racquet is to add a vibration dampener. The actual amount of vibration absorbed is practically negligible.

Last on the list, and probably the most important, is the string. A string has variable thickness from 15 to 18 gauge. The higher the number (18) the thinner the string. Some strings are stiff and don't have much give while other strings are flexible like a trampoline. Today you can choose a string by: color, size, shape, construction, durability, comfort and power. Some players have found that a racquet strung with two different strings can give you the best of both worlds. With this hybrid type of stringing, you can use a power or control string in the mains and get comfort with a softer string in the crosses.

Yet when it gets right down to it, what feels good for you is what you go with. Go play!

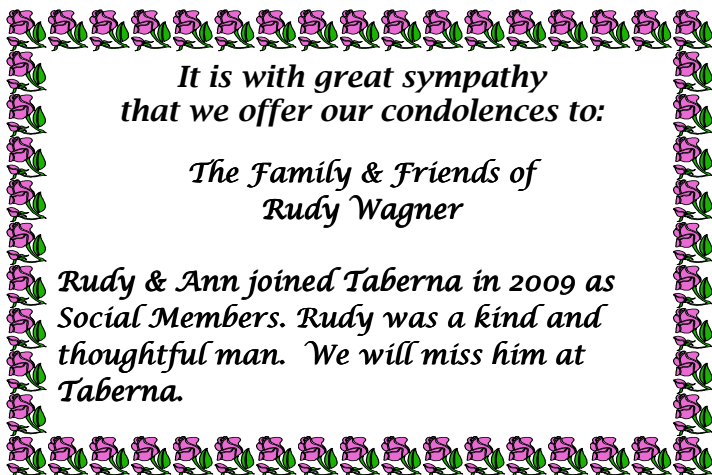
